

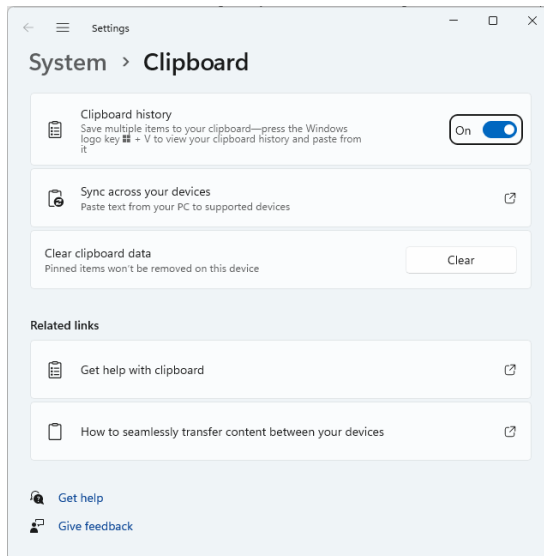
Using the Win10/11 Clipboard History in the APL64 Developer GUI

Overview

In Windows 11 and 10 the Clipboard history feature is available. The user may copy more than one item to the Clipboard and paste a user-selected Clipboard item from the history.

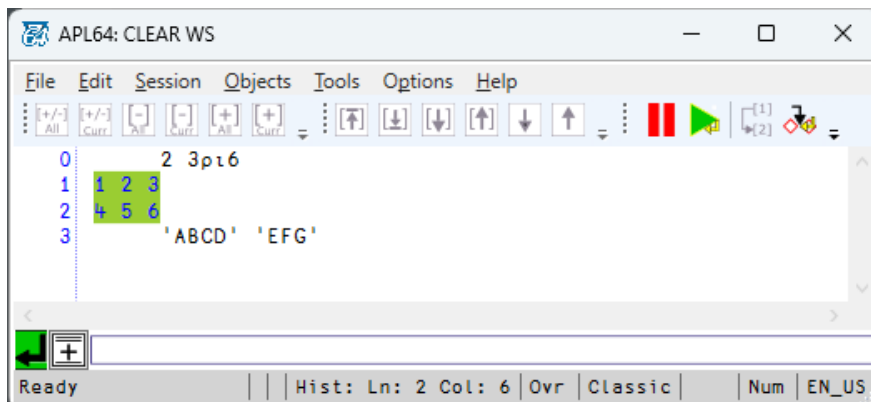
Enable the Clipboard History

Open the Clipboard Settings dialog and turn on the Clipboard History:



Copying to the Clipboard History

Make a selection and use the Ctrl+C keyboard shortcut to copy the selection to the Clipboard history:



Pasting a Selected Clipboard Item

Place the keyboard focus on the paste target. Instead of using the Ctrl+V keyboard shortcut, which will paste the most recent Clipboard entry, use the WindowsKey+V keyboard shortcut to open the Clipboard history dialog. Use Key.Up/Key.Down keystrokes to select the Clipboard history item to paste.
